Bridgeport's Family Resource Centers have been operating for 15 years, providing safe and secure places and staff who support families with education, information, programs and resources. The Family Resource Centers are located in four distinct neighborhoods in the city: the East End at Barnum/Waltersville School, the East Side at Dunbar School, the South End at Roosevelt School, and the West Side at Cesar Batalla School. The Family Resource Centers (FRCs) are located in elementary schools and are open all year as resources for the families in their neighborhoods.

The Family Resource Centers provide:

- Preschool childcare programs and playgroups, providing links with school readiness and head start programs;
- School-age programs and positive youth development activities, linking with the city-wide lighthouse programs;
- Adult Education classes including ESL, GED and computer instruction;
- "Parents As Teachers" home visiting and comprehensive parenting programs;
- Training for Family Day Care and "Kith and Kin" providers to enhance the care they provide to families;
- Family support and referral services including linkages to school and community programs and available resources such as housing, food, clothing, translations services, counseling and more.

Bridgeport's Family Resource Centers are four of sixty-two FRCs across the state and are actively involved in the state-wide Family Resource Center Alliance.
